1. This tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and all playing rules will apply, together with the following. All bowlers must produce their BTBA membership card at registration or a £1 fine will be levied. Non-members will not be eligible for BTBA services.
2. The tournament will be singles throughout (bowled at doubles pace). Each bowler will bowl 3 games and be placed in their relevant divisions by age.
3. **Squadding will take place on a first come first served basis and will be allocated by the Tournament Manager after the closing date.**
4. The tournament manager is Mr Lovegrove, who reserves the right to reject or re-rate and his decision on all matters shall be final subject to appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be lodged by the YBC official/player within 30 minutes and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
5. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to the squad start time. Bowl off will commence early if all bowlers are present and ready to bowl. Latecomers will commence at the frame in progress.
6. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages at any time during the tournament. Any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification. Inappropriate behaviour including profane language and improper gestures, or abuse of bowling equipment/machinery may also result in disqualification. Any disqualification will result in loss of scores and awards, the bowler will also be reported to the BTBA for consideration for disciplinary procedure.
7. Competitors will wear correct bowling attire in the playing area. Shirts should bear the players name and/or the name of their YBC. Sponsors names may also be included (but not alcohol and tobacco products). The wearing of headgear of any kind will only be permitted at the discretion of the tournament manager. Denim clothing, shorts or cargo style trousers will not be permitted (skorts however, are permitted). Mobile phones, MP3/CD players will not be permitted in the bowling area under any circumstances.
8. Only competitors, tournament officials and one licensed coach will be allowed in the playing area. Officials, instructors and coaches are not permitted to wear casual shorts, denim clothing or jeans of any description. All coaches must display their licence.
9. **The closing date for entries is Sunday 28th February 2010 (Midnight).**
10. All entry fees **MUST** accompany a fully completed entry form attached below. Pre booking of places will not be accepted and confirmation can only be made on receipt of full entry fee and booking form. Except in the case of cancellation of the tournament, no entry fees will be refundable after the closing date has passed. 11. The entry fee will be: **£11.85** per bowler which includes lineage £6.60, prize fund £3.00, (Prize fund will be returned 100%), administration £1.25 (comprising of 50p to NAYBC and 75p to YBC) and expenses £1.00 (provision of buffer lane and sundries).
