TOURNAMENT DETAILS:

1. The **SCJK 2011 Tournament** will comprise of two competitions: **Boys and Girls** Junior Knockout which will held over 2 days, it is sanctioned by the BTBA and all playing rules will apply (including rules on smoking, drinking, attire, behaviour etc).
2. All bowlers must be **under 19 years old on or before the 31st August 2011** and have a YBC Secretary certified scratch average in excess of **140 for boys** and **130 for girls**. They must produce a valid BTBA membership card at registration or a £3 fine will be levied.
3. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to the squad start time. Latecomers will commence at the frame in progress at the permission of tournament manager.
4. Squadding for qualifying will be allocated on a first come first served basis by the Tournament Manager. Times for each squad are shown on the Entry Form below.
5. **Saturday 11th June 2011 (Qualifying round 1):** Each bowler will bowl 5 games in Round 1 on lanes allocated through a random draw, moving lanes after the 3rd game. The top 32 boys and top 20 girls will be seeded according their scratch total scores and will progress to the Knockout stage (to be played on Sunday). The top 8 boys and 4 girls from this qualifying round will be given byes as shown below. Bowlers will be sent a text if they qualify for the knockout so please ensure the mobile number supplied in the application is legible and accurate.

6. **Sunday 12th June 2011 at about 1pm (Knockout round):** Qualifying bowlers will be entered in a random draw to determine their opponents and lane. Each round comprises of two games, the winner of each round will progress to next until 1st and 2nd places are found. Losers on penultimate round will play off for 3rd place. Seeded players will be inserted as described in appendix).
7. The tournament manager is Mr Lovegrove, who reserves the right to reject or re-rate and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be lodged by the YBC official/player within 30 minutes and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
8. Only competitors, tournament officials and/or licensed YBC instructors will be allowed in the playing area. Officials, instructors and coaches are not permitted to wear casual shorts, denim clothing or jeans of any description. All coaches must display their licence.
9. **Closing date for entries: Saturday 28th May 2011 (Midnight).**
10. All entry fees **MUST** accompany a fully completed entry form attached below. Pre-booking of places cannot be accepted and confirmation can only be made on receipt of full entry fee and booking form. Except in the case of outright cancellation of the tournament, no entry fees will be refundable after the closing date has passed. The tournament manager reserves the right to cancel should there be insufficient entries.

12. **Entry fee is £25.00 per bowler**, which includes lineage, prize fund and administration, (50p to NAYBC per bowler).
13. **PRIZE FUND** will be awarded on a pro rata basis dependent on number of entries to 1st, 2nd and 3rd boy and girl. A guaranteed minimum of £10.00 per bowler will be awarded to the prize fund and its size will dependant on the number of entries which will be published before the start of the tournament. If **100 boys and 50 girls** take part the prize for 1st place is estimated at £500 for boys and £250 for girls. (More entrants = higher prizes fund).
14. **This is a BTBA Tour Event.** Ranking Points will be awarded as follows: 100 points for first place boy and girl, followed by 99 for 2nd, 98 for 3rd and so on
