1. This is a Boy and Girls BTBA sanctioned scratch singles event to be bowled at doubles pace and entrants will be divided by age as below. A cash prize will be awarded to the winner of each category, subject to the number of entries and the presentation will be held within 30 minutes of receipt of all final scores.

Div A: 14 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div B: 13 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div C: 12 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div D: 11 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div E: 10 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div F: 09 years or under on 31st August 2011.

Div G: 08 years or under on the 31st August 2011 ([New div](#))

2. All bowlers must be BTBA Members and able produce a current BTBA card at registration otherwise a £1 fine will be levied. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to the start time. Bowl off will commence when all bowlers are present and ready. Latecomers will commence at the frame in progress.

3. Squadding will take place on a “first come first served” basis and lanes are allocated randomly after the closing date. The Tournament Manager Mr. Howard Lovegrove can allow reasonable flexibility to ease travelling of large groups, but reserves the right to reject or re-rate any bowler and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.

4. Protests during play must be lodged by a official and or player within 30 minutes and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.

5. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages at any time during the tournament and any infringement will result in immediate disqualification. Inappropriate behaviour including, profane language, improper gestures and or abuse of bowling equipment/machinery may also result in disqualification and result in the loss of scores and awards. The facts will also be reported to the BTBA.

6. Competitors must wear correct bowling attire in the playing area to satisfy BTBA expectations. Shirts bearing the players name and/or the name of their YBC are permissible. No sponsorship of alcohol and tobacco products is permissible. Denim clothing, shorts or cargo style trousers will not be permitted (skorts however, are permitted). The wearing of headgear as a fashion item is not permitted and will be at the discretion of the tournament manager. Personal electronic goods will not be permitted in the bowling area under any circumstances to maintain safety and minimize distraction to other bowlers.

7. Only competitors, tournament officials and licensed coaches will be allowed in the playing area. Spectators are expected to view from behind the threshold. Officials, instructors and coaches must observe the same dress code as above and must display appropriate identification.

8. Entry fees **MUST** accompany a fully completed entry form (see below). Confirmation of booking will be made by email only on receipt of full entry fee and booking form. Except in the case of cancellation of the tournament, no entry fees will be refundable after the closing date has passed. 9. The entry fee will be **£13.00** per bowler which includes lineage at £7.50, prize fund £3.50 (100% of the fund will awarded), administration £1.00 (comprising 50p to NAYBC and 50p to YBC) and expenses £1.00 (provision of buffer lane and sundries).
